TURTLE TROT

GuidedBell

Get up close and personal with a variety of wild turtles by helping Merry Lea Executive Director, Jason Martin, complete a survey of Kesling Wetland's turtle community. As you walk around the perimeter of the wetland, you will help check live traps, determine what turtle species are present, record important data, and learn about the ecology of these fascinating creatures. Wearing hip waders and entering the water is an optional part of this excursion.

TRASH CLEAN-UP Guided Bell
April Showers bring May flowers, but before that, they make all the trash visible along the edges of Merry Lea. Now is the time to pick up the bottles, wrappers and other debris that won't biodegrade before the vegetation grows up around it. If you are available, we'd love your help to collect and bag the trash. We will start at the Farmstead and move over to Rieth Village.

SEED STARTING Guided Farmstead Pavilion
Join us at the Teaching Farm for a seed starting workshop! Participants will take home their freshly potted seed to place in a sunny window and watch it grow. Learn more about plant families and companion plantings. Just like people, plants have relatives and friends they like to grow with! Pots, soil and several types of herbs, flowers and vegetable seeds are provided to choose from.

NATURAL ART SUPPLIES Guided Carpenter Shop
Come experiment with art supplies made from materials gathered at Merry Lea. Make pictures from plant pigments, make your own paint brushes and try them out, use charcoal paint, berry ink, and more.

NATIVE PLANT & ID HIKE Guided Bell
Merry Lea is home to hundreds of native plants, do you know their names? Let's take a walk together and see who is in bloom and who will be soon! Participants are encouraged to download the iNaturalist app to record their observations. No experience with plant identification or iNaturalist is necessary. We will go over the basics along the way.

Help Merry Lea continue to manage invasive plants! We have been working on several populations for many years and need to keep up the work to be effective. We will travel off trail over uneven terrain to look for garlic mustard and pull it. Long pants and closed toed shoes are required. This activity does not require heavy lifting, but there will be quite a bit of bending.
